#### Methodology


The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Friday, October 27th to Saturday, November 11th, 2023, among a sample of 946 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Florida. The survey was conducted using text message recruitment to complete the survey. Since the text messages were sent to random registered Florida voters the poll can be assigned a margin of error. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Florida.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 3.2% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.



In the most recent Midterm election (November 2022) which party did you vote for in the congressional elections? (all voters)







# Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as President? (all voters)







# Do you approve or disapprove of the way Ron DeSantis is handling his job as Governor? (all voters)







# Is your opinion of Donald Trump favorable, unfavorable or haven't you heard enough about him? (all voters)







If the election for President were held today, and the candidates were Joe Biden and Donald Trump, which candidate would you support? (all voters)







If the election for President were held today, and the candidates were Joe Biden and Ron DeSantis, which candidate would you support? (all voters)











## Do you support or oppose labor unions? (all voters)







## Are you a member of a Union or not? (all voters)





# Which personality trait do you value the most in a presidential candidate? (all voters)







## How old do you think Joe Biden is? (all voters)







## How old do you think Donald Trump is? (all voters)











# Did you support or oppose the removal of Kevin McCarthy as the GOP speaker of the House? (all voters)







## Do you approve or disapprove of Representative Matt Gaetz's performance as a member of Congress? (all voters)







# How important to your vote are the legal proceedings against former President Donald Trump? (all voters)







# How important to your vote are the investigations into President Biden and his son Hunter Biden? (all voters)







## In the Middle East situation, are your sympathies more with the Israelis or more with the Palestinians? (all voters)






